OUTREACH WORKSHOPS FOR STUDENTS

The Center offers basic, but engaging bookmaking and printing workshops to groups of students. Tailored to the needs of the group, workshops last 2 hours and cover basic book structures such as: pamphlets, simple hardcover albums, accordians, and pop-ups. Our printing workshops provide a hands-on typesetting demonstration and the opportunity to pull proofs while teaching the history of type. Students leave with both a conceptual and practical understanding of printing.

On-site workshops are capped at 15 students and are limited to individuals 12 years of age or older. A two-hour, on-site workshop is \$350. Advanced notice of at least two weeks is requested.

OFFSITE WORKSHOPS

These workshops are limited to bookbinding techniques only. Offsite workshops are limited to 15 students, though we've worked with larger groups in the past when appropriate supervision is provided by the hosting organization. A 2-hour, offsite workshop for up to 15 students is \$400. A \$50 fee is added to those groups larger than 15.
